Young Artists Camp -- Ballet	5-10	9:30am - 4:30pm	1	\$1,050 (\$535/wk)	Students enjoy a ballet-based exploration of the world of dance and performing arts, drawing from a variety of international cultures and illustrious folk traditions. All classes are professionally choreographed, exposing dance theatre traditions shared from generation to generation. Lessons are designed to improve technical skills, coordination, and concentration as well as cultivate artistry and an appreciation of music. Instruction also covers health and nutrition, makeup and hair for stage, video critique, theatre history, musical theatre and fencing for the stage. Students also participate in imaginative arts and crafts projects related to dance.
Ballet Intensive	11+	9:30am - 4:30pm	1	\$1,450 (\$750/wk)	Our summer ballet intensive focuses on improving technique and strength as well as expanding students' repertoire while maintaining a fun, focused environment. Using the Vaganova style of ballet, we incorporate barre, center, and variations for a well-rounded learning experience.
Young Artists Camp – Chinese Dance	5-10	9:30am - 4:30pm	2, 3	\$1,050 (\$535/wk)	Students will take classes in Chinese dance, tumbling, ballet, and folk dance in this two-week camp. The camp culminates in a showcase where students will demonstrate class routines and 1-2 short dance pieces. Each day, we will spend part of the afternoon doing traditional camp activities, such as arts and crafts, playing outdoors in Golden Gate park, and playing team building games. <i>This program is open to students with little to no experience with Chinese dance, and to current Xian Yun dance students who plan to enroll in Levels 1, 2, or 3 in the fall.</i>
Chinese Dance Intensive	9+	9:30am - 4:30pm	2, 3	\$1,450 (\$750/wk)	The goal of this intensive program is for students to advance their dance technique, flexibility, and tumbling skills. Students will engage in 3-4 hours of training and rehearsal each day. Arts & crafts and field trip outings may be scheduled, time permitting. <i>Student must be enrolled in Xian Yun's year-round Chinese Dance program and have successfully passed Level 3 to attend this program. Non-Xian Yun students with prior dance training may audition to join; please contact us for more details.</i>
Pre-Professional Art Camp	7+	9am – 12pm	2, 3	\$700 (\$375/wk)	This program is designed for students who seek professional training in drawing and painting while gaining hands-on experience with a wide range of art media, including ceramics, clay, and digital art.
Chinese Language and Culture Camp	6-12	9:30am – 4:30pm	1, 2, 3	\$880 (500/wk)	This program enhances structured language learning with a plethora of creative and practical activities. Students will improve their Chinese speaking and listening skills, also learn to read and write Chinese characters. Other parts of the program include Chinese dance, Chinese calligraphy, Chinese culinary art, Chinese painting, and Chinese culture and traditions. In addition, our immersion environment allows students to gain Chinese language skills and cultural knowledge in a natural way.
